- A product category (e.g., DVD burners) and NOT a specific brand has been chosen.
 - Guidelines for content described in the syllabus have been followed.
 - The paper focuses on *consumers'* experiences with the product and not on issues such as technology or the management philosophy of the inventors unless these issues are clearly and meaningfully tied to their impact on consumers.
